Bannockburn Heritage center

At the site of The Battle of Bannockburn, see the battle brought to life and stand shoulder-to-shoulder with medieval warriors during the 3D experience. Outside, wander across the parkland and admire the restored commemorative monuments, including the iconic statue of Robert the Bruce.

Stirling Castle and The Holy Rude

With its imposing position and impressive architecture, Stirling Castle is one of the largest and most important in Scotland. Knights, nobles and foreign ambassadors once flocked to Stirling Castle to revel in its grandeur with its superb sculptures and beautiful gardens. Enjoy the magnificent views and historical significance of the castle before stopping for lunch.

Lunch stop in Bridge of Allan

Bridge of Allan is a former spa town at the foot of the Ochil Hills, located just north of Stirling. Situated next to the river Allan, this is the perfect spot to stop for lunch and browse the local shops before heading to the next location.

Doone Castle

Explore this 14th century courtyard castle in Doone, with a striking 100ft high gatehouse and one of the best preserved great halls in Scotland. Doone castle is also more recently known as a prominent location where Outlander was filmed.

The Wallace Monument

See Sir William Wallace's legendary battle sword and enjoy panoramic views from the crown of the monument. As you climb towards the top, each level tells the story of Scotland's National hero-Sir William Wallace.
